The successful applicant will work with instructors to identify and develop supporting materials for these revised assignments.

- Continually meet with instructors for the duration of the appointment
- Assess how well 100- and 200-level Life Sciences course assignments align with learning outcomes
- Revise assignments while enabling complementary skill development as students' progress through these courses
- Develop marking rubrics, instructional resources for instructors and TA training sessions to facilitate evaluation of revised assignments
- Consult with faculty, writing instructors and other members of the Life Sciences community to ensure uniformity between 100- and 200-level Life Sciences courses
